2. Why did you decide to attend this event?

- I've been worrying and feel I need more education on the internet.
- We cannot protect our kids enough. The more we know, the better job we can do.
- How important it is to try to protect our children.
- Further my internet "education" to protect my children.
- I have 2 kids -- they are young at this time, but will get older and wanted some information. Very good information.
- To learn more about what kids do on the internet, risks associated, and what precautions to take.
- To become more informed, learn strategies to help keep my child safe. Also, ways to help me help my children understand that this is really dangerous - not just because I said it.
- We are concerned that our children could experience predators on sites and give information without knowing the risks.
- To do what I can to keep my kids safe. High in the EBD-SC program. Computers have become a big part of our lives and they (students) know more than I do.
