2003-2004 Summer School

Position Available:

Subject areas requiring teachers will include: American Democracy, Economics. This is a pilot program and one or two positions are available.

Position Description:

Teachers will provide instruction in these core academic classes for student credits or enrichment. Courses will be modeled on those offered during the regular school year with course content condensed from a regular semester. Students will meet with the instructor one day per week for 2 hours. However, students will do the majority of their work online from home or other location with internet access. Instructional time is flexible under this pilot program, as students will work at their own pace. Therefore, instructor time will also be flexible to allow for communication with students on a more timely basis. A date for meeting with parents and students prior to actual instruction will be set. In addition, meeting with District Online administration will be required to assess success of the pilot program.

Duties:

- Develop goals and objectives that are consistent with students' needs
- Plan, direct, monitor and evaluate instructional activities that promote student learning
- Perform appropriate duties that promote student learning
- Communicate with the parents regarding student achievement

The duties and responsibilities described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform these job functions.

1. Secondary teaching credential authorization in subject area for which teacher is applying
2. Teacher must qualify under NCLB (no child left behind) to be selected for this position.

The selection will be based upon:

1. Hiring priority will be as follows:
 - Teachers who are presently employed in the District
 - On a permanent contract basis
2. The endorsement of the candidate by current supervisor
3. The endorsement of the candidate by individuals involved in the selection process
4. A completed Summer School Application by the deadline date and meet District eligibility criteria
